Summer Camp Notes:

SAVE \$15 BY REGISTERING ON~LINE

All registered Campers will receive an e-mail confirmation noting dates of attendance, tuition due, and deposit paid.

If you need before or after camp care, we need to know so we can schedule our staff accordingly. Camp hours are daily 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Campers can be dropped off from 6:30 to 9:00 a.m. without any additional charge and can be picked up from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. without any additional charge. Parents who arrive after 6:00 p.m. to pick up their child(ren) will be charged a \$5 fee for the first 15 minutes their child(ren) stay(s) at camp beyond our 6:00 p.m. closing. The fee is increased to \$1 for every minute after 6:15 p.m. This fee is payable when arriving to pick your child(ren).



CAMP ORIENTATION

The Club will host two (2) orientations prior to the start of camp. Parents are encouraged to bring their child(ren)/teen(s) as staff will be on hand to meet and greet campers. The program lasts for just about an hour.

- **Grades 1 through 6 will meet Wednesday, June 17, 2009 at 6:00 p.m.**
- **Teen Campers (grades 7 and above) will meet Friday, June 19, 2009 at 6:00 p.m.**

FIELD TRIP NOTES:

- Please have campers at the Club by 8:45 a.m. on field trip days.
- State Park Field Trips will return by 4:00 p.m. and all other field trips will return by 5:00 p.m.
- All campers in Grades 1 - 6 **MUST WEAR** tie dyed t-shirt on ALL field trips.
- If a camper forgets his/her tie dyed t-shirt on day of field trip, one may be borrowed.
- New or replacement t-shirts incur a \$10.00 charge.
- Rainy Day - Thursday Field Trips **MAY BE** rescheduled for Friday.
- State Park field trips may be rescheduled for following day if the State Park can accommodate us.

Campers who owe a balance from last summer or from the school year must bring all accounts current to register for Camp Funtastic, 2009.

Financial Policies:

- Enrollment is limited and registrations will be taken on a first come/first served basis.
- All Campers must be current members of the Boys & Girls Club.
- All on-line registrations will be confirmed by e-mail.
- A non-refundable \$30 registration fee per camper is required for mail-in registration.
- A non-refundable \$15 registration fee per camper is required for on-line registration.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$35.00 per week/per child will be required upon registration.
- Tuition will be **\$155** per week with no additional extended care fees.
- All tuition balances must be PAID IN FULL BY JUNE 1, 2009.
- A \$25 fee will be assessed for all payments received after June 1, 2009.
- All deposits/fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** but may be transferred to another week if done by June 1, 2009.
- Any changes in enrollment after June 1, 2009, must be in writing and are subject to space availability. All changes incur a \$25 fee.
- For cancellations other than verifiable medical reasons, tuition can be refunded by providing an explanation in writing stating the reason for withdrawal two weeks prior to withdrawal.
- Checks returned to us by the bank will incur a \$25 charge.



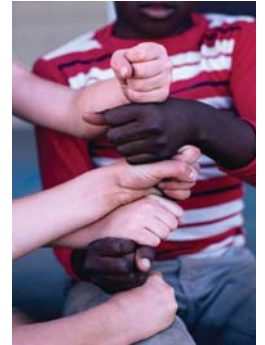
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

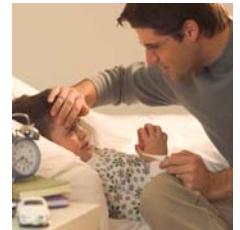


MEDICATION

All medications (prescription and non-prescription) brought to camp must be in the original container with the original prescription label attached. Written permission, signed and dated by the parent & physician, is also required. Campers may not transport medication. Medication must be administered by Boys & Girls Club professional staff only. If your child requires medication, please let us know so that a medication form can be mailed to you.

ILLNESS:

If your child becomes ill during our camp program, you may be called and asked to make arrangements to have your child picked up. If your child has been sick or is running a fever, he/she must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to camp.



CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

Due to the high demand for summer camp participation, all deposits and registration fees are **NON REFUNDABLE** but **MAY** be transferred to another week of done by **June 1, 2009.**



Any changes in enrollment - **including adding or deleting weeks** - made after June 1, 2009 must be submitted in writing and are subject to space availability.

CHANGES IN ENROLLMENT MADE AFTER JUNE 1, 2009 ARE SUBJECT TO A \$25 FEE.

TEEN CAMP

If your child is going into 7th grade or above, he/she may sign up for Teen Camp.

Teen Camp activities include:

cooking class, arts & crafts, Club Tech, fitness activities, trivia tournaments, games room tournaments, photography, Community

Service Projects, swimming & ice cream!!! Teen Camp follows the same daily schedule as Camp Funtastic with programs

running from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Daily activities vary and tuition is \$155 per week.

THINGS TO BRING TO CAMP FUNTASTIC



LUNCH

Lunch is not provided for campers. Be sure to bring a lunch each day of camp. Campers do not have access to microwave ovens or refrigerators. Please pack lunches accordingly.

BATHING SUIT & TOWEL

Please send your child(ren) to camp each day with a bathing suit and towel as campers swim most days

SUNSCREEN

Remember to send your child(ren) to camp each day with sunscreen. An SPF 15 is the minimum level of sun protection requested.

SNACKS & DRINKS

Remember to send your child(ren) to camp each day with snacks and drinks to protect against dehydration. Vending machines are also available to campers.

SPENDING MONEY FOR FIELD TRIPS

Campers may bring a small amount of spending money on field trips. Admission and the associated costs of field trips are included in camp tuition.
